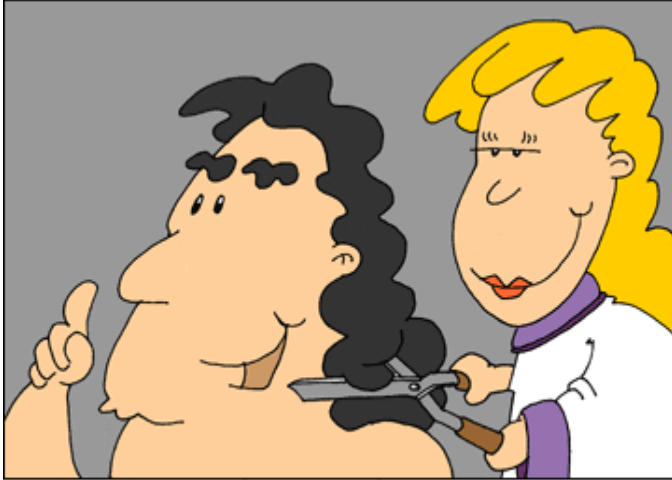

Read Judges 4

What did Jael do with a tent peg? Why?

Read Judges 13:1-7

Highlight v 1, 4-5. What was Samson supposed to do? Not supposed to do?

Read Judges 15:4-5, 9-16

Highlight v 14-15. Where did Samson get his strength?

Read Judges 16

How did Delilah trick Samson? Who was the real hero in this story and the other stories in Judges?

What do you think of the idea that God uses people the way they are, not the way they ought to be?

Caring Conversation:

What are the idols of American culture that many parents worship? That many teenagers worship? (Youth and parents both share)

Connection:

What do judges do today? Find out about three different judges this week (TV judges, Supreme Court judges, etc). How are these judges the same as judges in biblical times? How are they different?
